The Killearn Estates Toys for Tots campaign was a huge success. It was our most successful year as we doubled our efforts and doubled the number of large donation boxes from two to four. Thank you to our Killearn Estates families and all of our community members.

The Toys for Tots is a worthwhile organization coordinated locally by Marc Dickieson, a retired Marine. The impact to our local area in 2021 was impressive. Toys distributed in our area was 8,777 and the total number of children supported was 3,371. 2022, is planned to exceed those numbers. In fact you, Killearn, can claim at least 100 children supported. Thank you from the bottom of our hearts.

Toys for Tots has grown since 1947 with over 700 local communities in 50 states. The Marines motto for Toys for Tots has been "Every child deserves a little Christmas". Families do apply online and through our local support organizations such as the Angel Tree program and the Salvation Army. Other local support includes toy raising events, printing, transportation, and allowing drop off points.

## Garbage – Be a Part of the Solution, Not the Pollution

Hello Neighbors!

Every homeowner deals with issues related to their garbage. Some only have to worry about residential services, while others have to worry about yard waste, electronic trash, or construction debris. In any case, here are some tips and tricks to get ahead of issue as we come into the new year!

Below, please find the pickup schedule for different types of waste per the City of Tallahassee:

Item	Pickup Frequency
Bulky items	Every other week ( <b>red or blue week</b> )
Construction debris	By request
Electronics (residential)	By request every Thursday
Garbage	Once a week
Hazardous waste	Not picked up by the City
Recycling	Once a week ( <i>same day as garbage</i> )
Yard waste	Every other week ( <b>red or blue week</b> )

### Some items to note include:

Each address in Killlearn is assigned a designation straight from the City of Tallahassee, either red or blue. This designation dictates the week that you can expect special pickups such as bulky items, yard waste, etc.

The City of Tallahassee asks that all garbage items be placed out **no earlier than the day before scheduled pickup**. Additionally, the city also requires that all garbage receptacles be returned to their proper storage location **no later than the day after service has been conducted**.



Hello Neighbors,

As the holiday season comes around, we wanted to take a moment to reflect on an issue that has caused repeated concern within our community, speeding.

Whether it's a late alarm or an unexpected obstacle in your morning routine, speeding is never worth the risk that it brings to your surrounding community.

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration states that almost 12,000 people were killed by speeding and reckless driving in 2020 alone. Speeding reduces that amount of time that a driver has to react to the road and increases the chances of serious injury occurring to the driver and their community in the event of an accident.

In Tallahassee, we have all heard countless stories of civilians being seriously hurt or killed by speeding drivers in all areas of town. For some, it's an unfortunate headline that they read in the morning paper, but for others, it's a life changing event that could have been easily avoided if another person made the conscious choice of watching their speed.

Those few minutes that you saved by speeding down a congested road are never worth the risk of changing

someone's life forever. Each driver on the road is someone's parent, child, or loved one; please keep that in mind when you consider speeding.

KHA has partnered with the Tallahassee Police Department to invite them to increase their patrols through our neighborhood. We hope that the increased police presence will make speeders think twice before driving recklessly throughout Killlearn.

If you happen to see any instances of speeding throughout the community, feel free to report this directly to the Tallahassee Police Department using the DigiTally App. A short guide is included below to help facilitate these reports.

In all, speeding is a community problem that needs to be solved as a community. **Please make the effort to watch your speed and practice cautious driving when driving throughout our community.** 🍀

### How to Report Speeding Online?



1. Open Apple App Store or Google Play Store and search for "DigiTally"



2. On the bottom bar, click on "Request"

3. Scroll down to the tab labeled "Police and Fire"

4. On the next page, click "Police"



5. Scroll down to the tab labeled "Traffic Enforcement"

6. Provide the closest address to where the speeding was noted

7. Submit report

These steps will help guide the Tallahassee Police Department toward areas where speeding is a particular issue. If residents band together to report instances of speeding whenever they are seen, this will allow TPD to establish "trouble areas" where they can focus their efforts.

## Safety First

### COUNTRY CLUB AREA RISKS

The new owners of Killlearn Country Club are doing a yeoman's task of renovating the golf course and rebuilding the entire site of the country club to its prior grandeur—and better!

Before the renovation and demolition started, Killlearn residents had become accustomed to walking, driving golf carts, and in other ways, using the area for activity even if they did not play golf.

However, now that full-scale work is underway, risks exist for injuries by continuing those activities. Among other things, the ground is no longer uniformly flat, and sprinkler heads have been removed, leaving holes in the ground. Further, because the Country Club buildings were old, asbestos was used in their construction. As they have been or are in the process of being demolished, the asbestos has been exposed, which can carry health risks. People working on-site also need access to all areas during work hours, and that access should not be disrupted.

We urge you to be aware of these issues, alert others to them, and stay clear of the Country Club area for your activities for the time being. It will be well worth the wait. 🍀
